Community Support Program for Individuals with Justice-Involvement

Serving Individuals with Justice-Involvement who have Substance Use Disorder, Mental Health Disorder or Co-Occurring Disorder in Massachusetts.



What can I expect if I participate in the program?

Community Support Program for Individuals with Justice-Involvement (CSP-JI), is a community based coordination and support service, that promotes long-term recovery from substance use, mental health, and co-occurring disorders with the goal of reducing recidivism.

A CSP-JI service plan is tailored around the unique needs of individuals being served. Each participant is encouraged and guided in driving the goals and objectives of the plan as he or she progresses through the different stages of recovery.

CSP-JI is intended to maximize the ability of those experiencing reentry, parole supervision, and/or probation supervision to engage with behavioral health services and attain and maintain tenure within the community.

Who is eligible?

The following individuals will be considered for admission: former inmates/detainees of a correctional institution released within the past year or individuals under the risk/need supervision of the MA Probation Service or MA Parole Board. Individuals must also be 18 years of age and possess a substance use disorder, mental health disorder, or co-occurring disorder.

How do I apply?

Referrals are accepted from behavioral health and other community based providers, MA Probation Service and MA Parole Board. Once completed, your referral form will be sent to the CSP-JI Project Director. If accepted, the CSP-JI program will notify you through the reentry department at the correctional institution, the MA Probation Service, or the MA Parole Board to begin services.

What services are offered?

- Comprehensive reentry planning
- Case management and support services
- Discharge planning
- CSP-JI service planning
- Substance Use Disorder Treatment
- Mental Health Disorder Treatment
- Integrated Treatment for Co-Occurring Disorders
- Addressing criminogenic needs through intervention and strategies for developing alternative behavior
- Assisting consumers with coordinating appointments with medical providers, employers, etc. and providing access to transportation
